



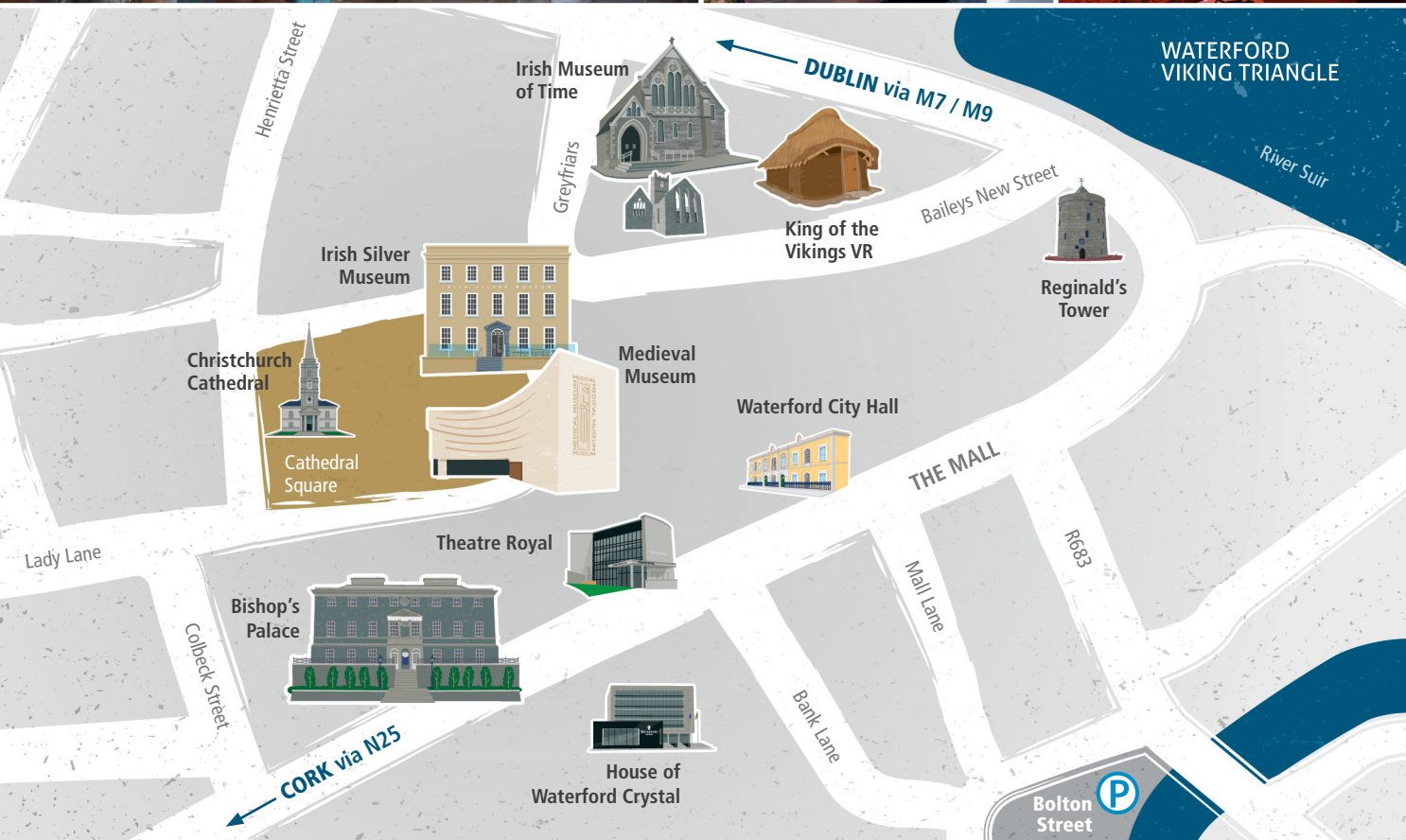

Enjoy an authentic 18th century Georgian grand residence built in 1743.

Don't miss: the oldest surviving piece of Waterford crystal in the world (1789) and the only surviving gold mourning cross commissioned by Napoleon's mother on the Emperor's death in 1821.
